❖ **STEM Night**

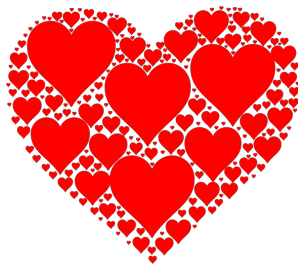
