LITTLE ARTISTS

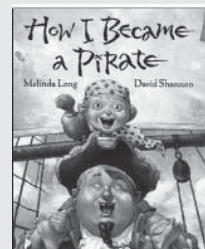
Thu., Sep. 13, 11:00 AM-11:30 AM
