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School Attendance

Harris Elementary is responsible for teaching your child. But we can't do our job if your child is absent. Learning builds day by day. A child who misses a day of school misses a day of learning.

Research shows that children who are in school most of the time do better on state tests. Being late for school hurts a child's learning too. A student who is 10 minutes late every day will miss 30 hours of instruction during the year. Children can make up an assignment, but they can never get back what is most important: the discussions, directions, questions, explanations by the teacher, and the thinking that makes learning come alive. Your child's success in school depends on having a solid educational background-one that can only be gained through regular school attendance.

Please help us reach our Harris 2012-2013 attendance goal of 97% by making sure your child is in school every day during the months of April and May.

Character Quality: Compassion

"You've Got a Friend in Me" is the theme song written for the movie Toy Story (it also appears in Toy Story 2 & 3). The lyrics talk about the compassion one person might have for another. In part, the words to the song say: "You've got a friend in me.....You've got troubles, well I've got 'em too......There isn't anything I wouldn't do for you......We stick together and we see it through.......You've got a friend in me

We all have troubles at some time....it may be that we've forgotten our lunch at home, or that a friend is being mean to us, or that we miss a grandparent. These are times when we might need to talk to someone or to have help in solving the problem. This is where a person who shows the character quality of Compassion can be helpful. That person will know what to do because they will be following the 5 "I Will" statements:

Stop to help.
Listen when others want to talk.

Comfort others without regard to race, gender, faith, age or nationality.

Give of my resources to help those in need.

Look for lasting solutions.
