During the month of October, we will be learning about the character quality of Truthfulness. This is one of the most valued character qualities. Character First! Defines truthfulness as "Earning future trust by accurately reporting past facts."

The five "I Will" statements are:

- I will tell the truth.
- I will encourage others to tell the truth.
- I will not cheat or steal.
- I will admit it when I am wrong.
- I will not exaggerate to make things seem different than what they

are.

When thinking about elementary aged (and younger) students, the "I Will" statements sometimes become difficult. Children of this age might not be able to report details accurately. may misunderstand information, may fear punishment, ridicule, or disapproval, or may simply want to avoid getting into trouble. Whatever the reason, it is important that children learn the value of telling the truth at a young age. To help children learn the benefits of truthfulness, it is important for honesty to be praised.


