TRANSPORTATION FUND – Provides transportation for disabled Veterans to the Indianapolis Vet Center FREE of charge. The van is run by volunteers and transports Veterans weekly. In an effort to better serve Veterans, the fund is in need of money for a new van and volunteer drivers.

VET FUND – The Vet Fund provides support to Veterans and their families in need of money for housing, utilities, medical services and other essential family support expenses which have become difficult to afford.
